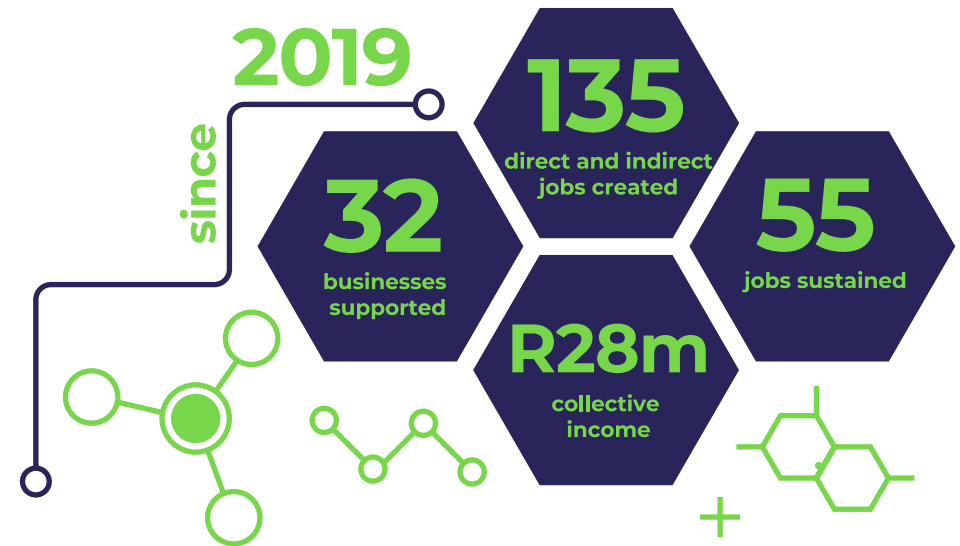


BioCiTi Membership – Corporates and Partners

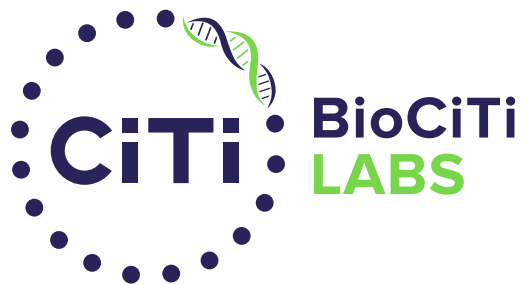
